The purpose of this verification of competency is to allow the nominee to demonstrate their understanding and competence to safely operate a wacker packer (vibration plate).

This verification of competency consists of two parts. One theoretical assessment and one practical assessment.

Section One – Theoretical Assessment

The nominee needs to have knowledge and awareness of the functions of the wacker packer and some other common information associated with the operation of the wacker packer.



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The assessor must be satisfied that the nominee has the ability to safely operate the wacker packer in a range of tasks that involve general maintenance.

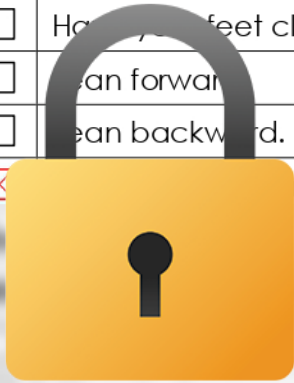
